- You feel unwell and need to see a doctor before your next scheduled appointment.

Your condition will be assessed by a nurse and advice will be provided.

- You have finished your medication and need to replenish it.

You will be advised on the appropriate daytime to collect your prescription. Do note that your condition may need to be assessed before a prescription can be given. If required, an appointment will be arranged for you.

TRIAGE &/OR BLOOD TESTS

- Height & Weight
- Blood Pressure
- Blood Tests (if required)*
- Assessment by Nurses

* Blood tests' results will be ready in approximately 2 hours.

CONSULTATION

- Please provide results of any other tests (e.g: MRI, CT Scans, blood tests, etc) that you may have done outside of NUH.
- After consultation, the clinic assistant will arrange for your next follow-up appointment and advise you if any preparation is required.

COLLECTION OF MEDICATION

- Collection of medication will be at Level 9.
- Do inform the pharmacist (upon arrival) should you require any dosage change.
- Please note that we have a strict no-refund policy.



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ONE-STOP PAYMENT

- One-stop payment is available at all NCIS counters (Levels 9 & 10).
- Medisave may be used for selected tests / procedures / medications. Please verify with our counter staff.



OTHER NOTES:

- Please note that priority may be given to patients who are ill and/or require urgent medical attention.
- Please provide a valid phone number for contact purposes should you leave the centre during waiting times.
- If you are expected to be in the centre for long treatment (e.g. chemotherapy), you may wish to:
 - Bring your own sweater
 - Bring your own food / light snacks (especially if you have any dietary restrictions)
