#### Q: How long have you been volunteering at NCIS?

She had fallen asleep in the chair and looked cold and uncomfortable. I looked for a blanket, went over and draped it over her. She roused from her sleep and gave me such a genuine smile of gratitude I don't think I'll forget anytime soon. I felt really great.

#### Q: Are there any things you've learnt or picked up from your volunteering experiences?

A: I've learnt so much – from an overview of how hospitals in Singapore operate to handling a wheelchair. I've also learnt the importance of listening and paying attention to details. Many times, patients don't come to you for help directly. You've to observe closely and take the initiative to approach them sometimes.

A: I'll say go for it! Don't be afraid of accepting a new challenge or a little change in your life. Volunteering at NCIS just might become one of the most rewarding experiences you've ever had.
