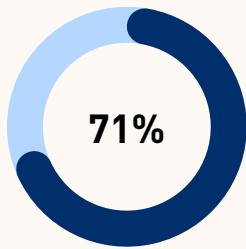

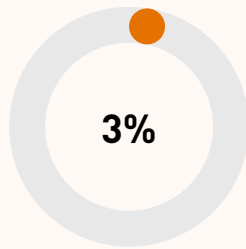

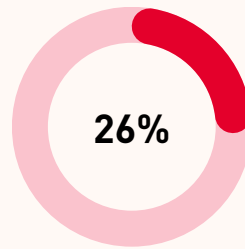
Citizenship (by Approved Data)



Singapore Citizen

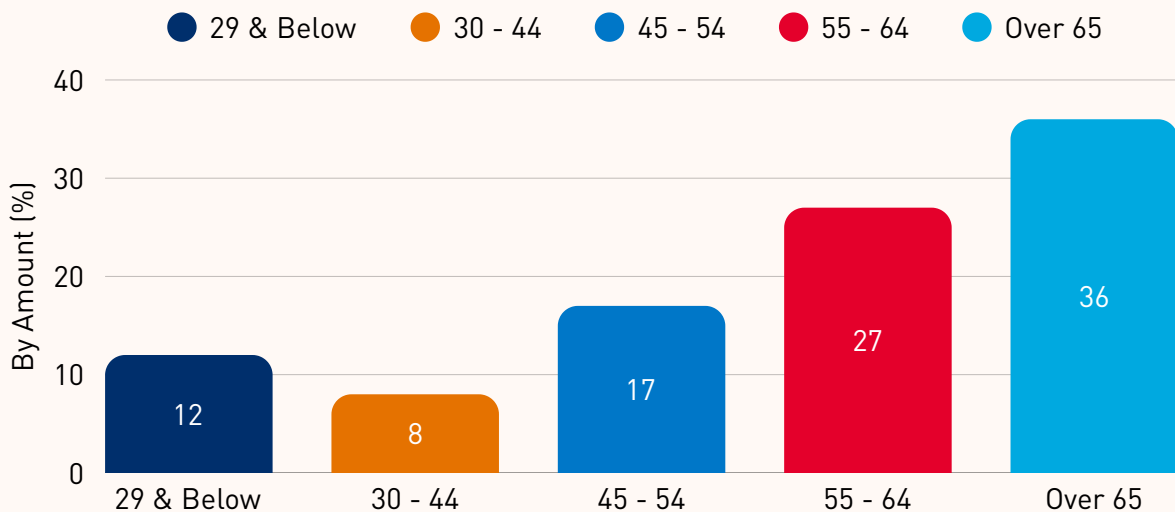


Permanent Resident

Age Group (by Approved Amount)



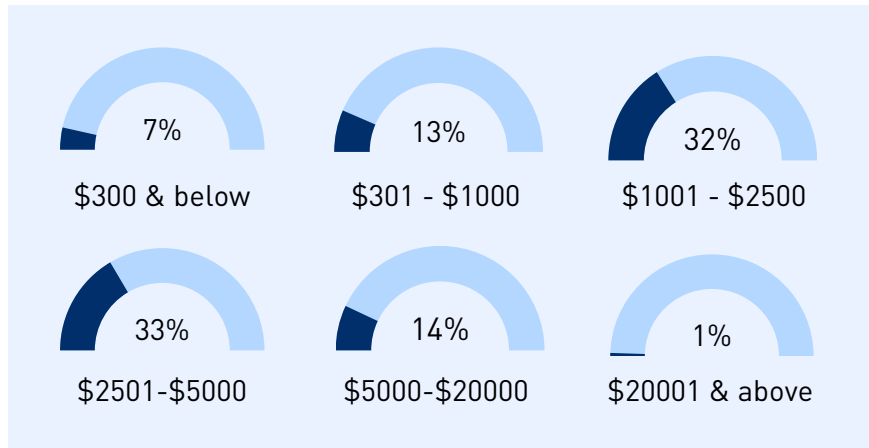
The largest segment (aged 65 and above) reflects the prevalence of chronic diseases in an ageing population.

Funding Range (by Application Data)



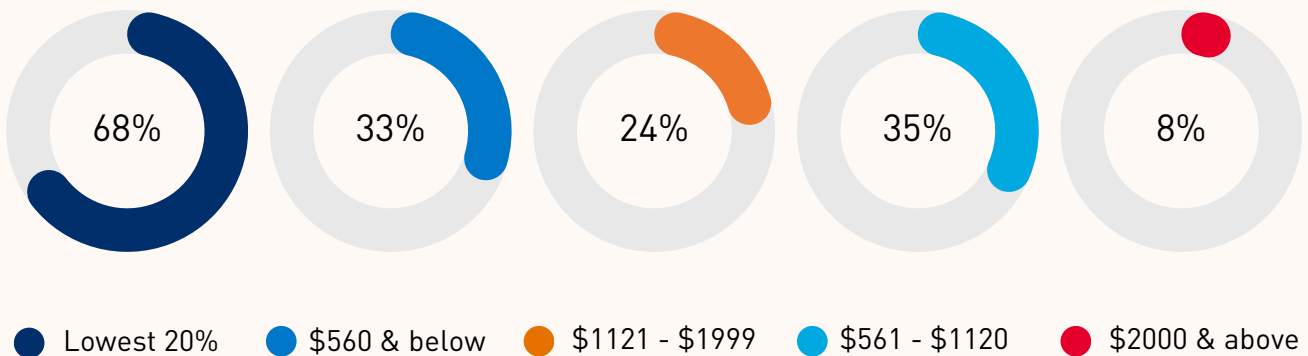
Total Amount of Monetary Assistance Disbursed:

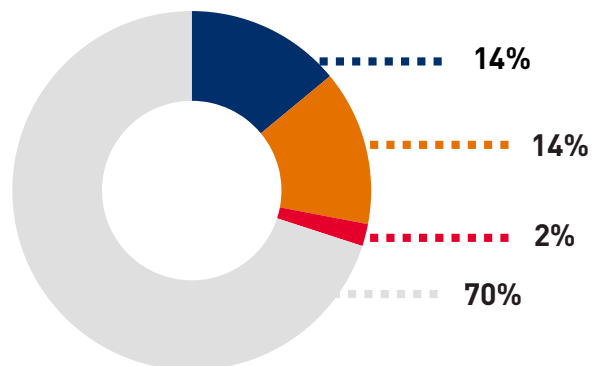
- Funding support provided is crucial to our beneficiaries as their medical expenses exceed their per capita income.

Funding is provided to support treatment costs not funded by existing assistance schemes. The majority of patient funding support is for PET scans. This helps physicians detect cancer, evaluate the extent of disease, select the most appropriate treatments, determine if the therapy is working and detect any recurrent tumours.
